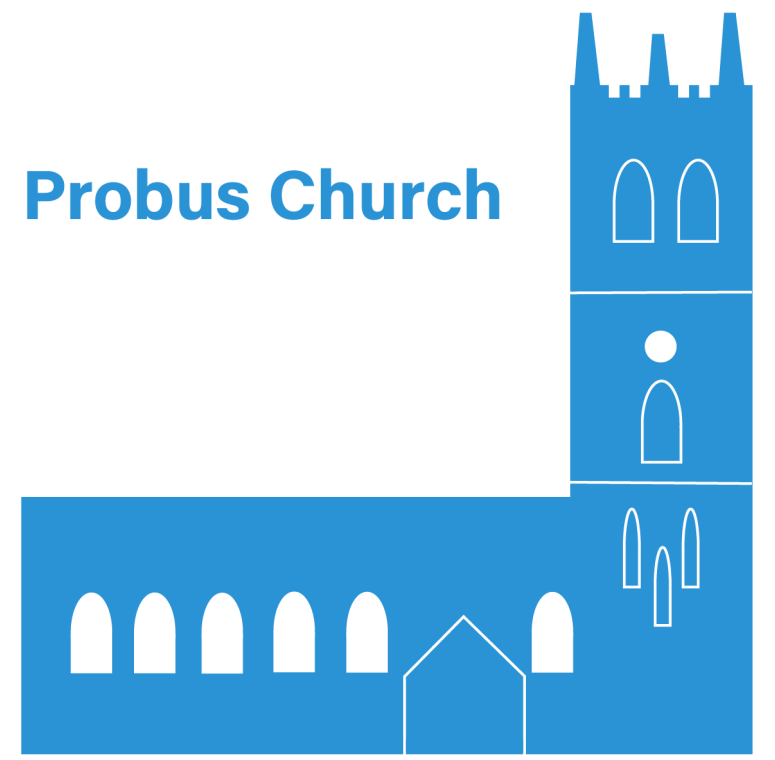


# Probus Churchyard

## Maintenance



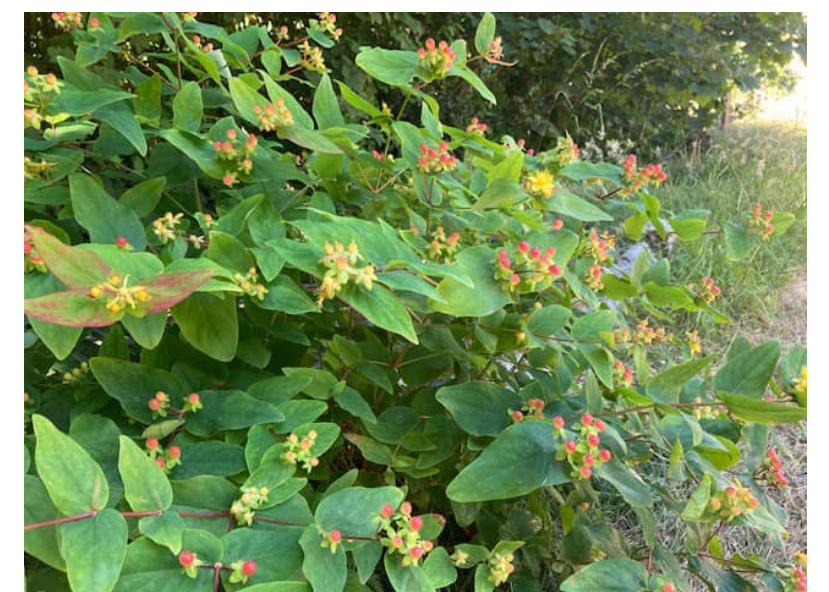
As the churchyard 'closed' many years ago when it no longer had new plots available for burial the responsibility for its maintenance transferred to Cornwall Council.

Over the past decades the basic maintenance of the churchyard that was offered by Cormac has been kindly supplemented by the Parish Council and I think all the village appreciate the work and the money spent on the maintenance of the churchyard over the years

In the current economic climate and with a renewed focus on increasing biodiversity in all of our green spaces the additional monthly strimming of the grass is no longer going to be funded by the Parish Council. The Church supports this decision.

In order to supplement the basic maintenance that will be Cormac funded (approximately 3 cuts of the grass per year) we are extremely pleased that a community group is being established led by Steve Dalton and Nick Lauder and it's aim is to manage and improve this beautiful and peaceful space in the heart of our village by developing a mix of 'maintained wild' and maintained areas.
